## **Directions to Charis Canyon**

NOTE: GPS units cannot accurately find the exact location of Charis Canyon by its physical address. If you want to use a GPS, then enter "Barksdale, TX" as your destination city, and then resume the directions below at step #9.

- 1. Go I-10 West to San Antonio.
- 2. Stay on I-10 in San Antonio, and watch for US 90 West.
- 3. I-10 breaks off to the right (North) but stay on 90-W to Castroville/Uvalde.
- 4. Stay on 90-W through Castroville, Hondo, D'Hanis, Sabinal, Knippa, and finally into Uvalde.
- 5. You will pass HEB on the left. Go a couple of blocks further to the red light, and take a right onto TX-55.
- 6. As you come out of Uvalde on TX-55, you will go over a bridge.
- Take a 90' left turn to stay on TX-55 at the bottom of the bridge, heading towards Camp Wood, rather than staying on US-83 to Leakey.
- 8. Stay on TX-55 through Camp Wood to Barksdale (4 miles north of Camp Wood, on TX-55).
- 9. Upon entering Barksdale, slow down to 10 mph (usually a speed trap here), and look for a green and black H&R Block sign on the right. Take the first right turn after the sign (directly opposite from the First Baptist Church sign).
- 10. Go about 4 ½ miles, alternating between paved and gravel roads. You will pass over 4-5 cattle guards; don't worry, you're on the right path!
- 11. Entrance will be on the left. Look for the wooden Charis Canyon sign.
